

- 1. **Bible study leader:** They are responsible for developing and executing a plan for the Bible study for the school year. They will schedule Bible teachers to lead each week. Lastly, they see to it that what is being taught falls within the parameters of Games Reach's "What we believe" statement.
- 2. **Care Closet coordinator:** Maintains good communication with a school representative regarding the ongoing needs of their Care Closet. They also facilitate the gathering of needed supplies within their church or within Games Reach as a whole, where needed.
- 3. **Communications Assistant:** They Assist the "Marketing and Communications Coordinator" as needed within their specific area. ""(Website, Facebook, Snapchat, Tic toc... etc.)
- 4. **Community Engagement Liaison:** Cultivates relationships with parents, teachers, and local community members to garner support and involvement in Games Reach.
- 5. **Curriculum Developer:** Designs educational materials and lesson plans for a VBS.
- 6. **Event Planning Specialist:** Plans and organizes board game events, tournaments, Family Game nights, summer activities and, supports the fundraising Coordinator as needed.
- 7. **Fundraising Coordinator:** Develops and implements fundraising strategies to support Games Reach's initiatives and expansion. (works with Event Planning Specialist where needed)



- 8. **Game leader:** Teaches students how to play board games, facilitates discussions about game strategies, and promotes critical thinking through gameplay.
- 9. **Game Library Curator:** Maintains the game library of Games Reach. This includes...
  - a. Replacing broken/missing parts and related storage and transportation gear
  - b. Researching and purchasing new games
  - c. Requesting game donations
  - d. Deciding what games to part with
  - e. Maintaining the Game catalog with corresponding "How to play QR codes
- 10. **Graphic Design and Visual Content Creator:**Designs visually appealing materials, such as flyers, infographics, and posters, to support programming and the work of other volunteers.
- 11. **Marketing and Communications Coordinator:**Manages the organization's marketing efforts, including social media, newsletters, and promotional materials, to raise awareness about Games Reach.



- 12. **Parent Support Coordinator:** Develops programming to encourage the parents of the students we serve. They do this By...
  - a. <u>Fostering Good Communication</u>: The parent support coordinator maintains open lines of communication to parents and guardians. This helps them to feel connected and enables us to offer emotional encouragement as well.
  - b. Encouraging parents: to
- 1. participate regularly by communicating that we would love to have them join their child at any Games Reach event.
- 2. As well as invite parents to volunteer for Games Reach.
  - c. <u>Organize Parent Workshops:</u> On various topics related to child development, learning strategies, and effective parenting techniques.
- 13. **School Coordinator:** Engages with schools to establish partnerships, schedule workshops, Game Club sign-ups and coordinate board game clubs and Bible studies.
- 14. **Staff support coordinator:** Organizes regular teacher appreciation gatherings, staff prayer meetings, and the placement of encouraging notes in mailboxes.
- 15. **Table leader:** Leads the overall direction and conversation at a given table. They are responsible for maintaining a calm learning environment and handling any behavior issues. The table leader can also be a game leader.
- 16. **Tech Support Specialist:** Assists with the setup and maintenance of technological components, such as digital tools, audio and visual needs, and online platforms.



- 17. **Video Content Producer:** Creates engaging video content related to Games Reach programming.
- 18. **Volunteer Coordinator:** Recruits, trains, and supports volunteers involved in the various programs of Games Reach.
